Florida Power Corporation's letter 3F-0981-27, dated September 1, 1981, transmitted proposed Revision 3 to the Crystal River Unit 3 Physical Security Plan, in accordance with 10CFR50.90. As a result of numerous Staff comments, Florida Power Corporation submitted proposed Revision 4 to the Plan by letter 3F-0582-07, dated May 6, 1982. In letters 3F-0183-16 and 3F-0383-10, dated January 20, 1983 and March 7, 1983, respectively, Florida Power Corporation responded to Staff comments and made several minor changes to the original submittal of Revision 4. It is anticipated that within the next several weeks, an update to proposed Revision 4 to the Plan will be forwarded to incorporate several editorial changes and the security measures to be in effect during construction of the new administration and warehouse buildings on site, as reflected in a recent 10CFR50.54(p) change.

In anticipation of providing your office with the updated proposed Revision 4 to the Plan, this letter forwards a proposed Significant Hazards Evaluation for the Plan. The proposed Significant Hazards Evaluation, Enclosure 1, is intended to complete the application for amendment to the Crystal River 3 license which will place Revision 4 into effect.

The appropriate officials of the State of Florida have been advised of this amendment in accordance with 10CFR50.91(b)(1).


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In order to expedite the processing of this application for amendment to the license, a proposed Federal Register Notice is included as Enclosure 2.
