

MRO SIX (6) MONTH REPORT

From July 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994, our records indicate one confirmed positive (each) in the pre-access, follow-up and for-cause (observed behavior) programs for Duquesne Light Company employees.

Pre-Access and Follow-up

On July 6, 1994, an employee experienced a confirmed positive test result in the pre-access program. The employee was denied unescorted access, completed an evaluation by the EAP provider, and initiated intensive out-patient rehabilitation. On the recommendation of the EAP, the employee was returned to work on August 9, 1994, while attending an evening out-patient counselling program. Unescorted access was not granted at this time and follow-up testing was initiated. On September 20, 1994, the employee successfully completed rehabilitation and continued in individual sessions.

On November 25, 1994, the employee experienced a confirmed positive test result in the follow-up program and, on November 28, 1994, employment was terminated.

Unescorted access was never obtained.

For-Cause - Observed Behavior

On November 30, 1994, an employee had a confirmed positive intoxilyzer test result in the for-cause program. The employee was denied unescorted access, was evaluated by the EAP provider, and was placed in an intensive out-patient rehabilitation program which was completed on December 30, 1994.

On January 3, 1995, the employee was returned to work and placed in a follow-up program. At this time, unescorted access has not been reinstated.

Follow-up to Previous MRO Reports

As previously reported in the Performance Report of January 1, 1994 to June 30, 1994, one employee had a confirmed positive in the for-cause (observed behavior) program and was denied unescorted access. This person completed an evaluation and intensive out-patient treatment program with the EAP and on August 1, 1994, was returned to work and placed in a follow-up program. Unescorted access was not reinstated.

On October 10, 1994, employment for this individual was terminated for failure to adhere to the mandatory requirements of the rehabilitation program as determined by the EAP provider.
