Proposed Revision to License Condition  
and Technical Specifications  
Fire Protection

By letter dated December 21, 1994,<sup>(1)</sup> Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) submitted an amendment request to the NRC Staff which would amend the Operating License, DPR-65, of Millstone Unit No. 2. The proposed changes would revise License Condition 2.C.(3), and various sections of the Technical Specifications and Bases associated with the Fire Protection Program. These changes were proposed in accordance with Generic Letter 86-10 to relocate provisions related to the Fire Protection Program from the Technical Specifications to another controlled document, the Technical Requirements Manual.

In the referenced letter, both marked up and retyped pages of the affected License Condition and Technical Specifications were included as attachments. In a telephone conversation between NNECO and the NRC Project Manager, it was confirmed that the format of the marked up License Condition pages submitted by NNECO do not match that of the authority file copy maintained by the NRC Staff. It has been determined that, due to word processing constraints, the font style of the NNECO maintained version was changed, resulting in pagination that differs from the NRC copy. In our submittal, paragraph 2.C.(3) appears on page 3, and paragraph 2.D

through the end of the document appears on page 4. The NRC authority file copy has paragraph 2.C.(3) on page 4, and paragraph 2.D through the end of the document on page 4a. It was mutually agreed that we would modify the pages of our proposed License Condition to be in conformity with the NRC authority file format.

The purpose of this letter is to resubmit marked up and retyped pages of the proposed License Condition that conform to the NRC authority file format. The proposed License Condition change, transmitted via the December 21, 1994, letter, has been reformatted to reflect the above discussion and modified, at the Staff's request, to include a provision to insert the date of amendment issue. The proposed License Condition now affects only page 4, and is included herein as Attachments 1 and 2.


NNECO has reviewed these changes with respect to the Safety Assessment, Significant Hazards Consideration and Environmental Considerations, provided to the Staff in the December 21, 1994, letter, and has determined that these sections remain valid and applicable to these changes.

We believe the above information, coupled with the information provided in the referenced letter, provides a complete basis for approval of the requested amendment.
