RESOLUTION NO. 12 - 1984
INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMAN SCOTT - FEBRUARY 14, 1984
ADOPTED BY COUNCIL - FEBRUARY 14, 1984

WHEREAS, on March 28, 1979, the nation's worst commercial nuclear accident occurred at Three Mile Island, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, since the time of the accident there has been a continuous effort to clean up Unit 2, while Unit 1 has remained in cold shut down; and

WHEREAS, during this period, there has been a great deal of concern expressed regarding management issues and certain potential safety questions at Three Mile Island; and

WHEREAS, on January 27, 1984, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission voted to separate the management issues from the TMI 1 restart decision; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that any questions regarding safety and management at Three Mile Island be resolved before any consideration is given to the restart of the reactor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Lancaster hereby opposes the decision of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission made on January 27, 1984, to separate management issues from the Three Mile Island Unit 1 reactor restart decision and, by copy of this Resolution, requests the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to reconsider their decision.
