Dear Administrative Judges:

In response to your recent inquiry, be informed that the CEG technical review of UCLA's "Shutdown Analysis" was performed by Boyd Norton, Michio Kaku, Miguel Pulido, Steven Aftergood, and myself.

On an unrelated matter, the Board in a recent Memorandum and Order made comments regarding the timeliness of CEG's complaint about the timeliness of UCLA's security plan in the context of due date for timely renewal application. To set the record straight, the Board should be advised that CEG only recently learned of the untimeliness of the UCLA submission of its security plan. CEG did not know four years ago, when the rest of the application was publicly submitted, that the security plan was untimely filed, for the obvious reason that the security plan was not publicly submitted, being protected safeguards information. Only one member of CEG's team to date has even seen the plan, and that was only last week. CEG learned of the untimeliness of its filing only through a recent reference to its date of filing contained in a recent public Staff document.
