This letter provides PP&L's response to your letter of January 4, 1984, which forwarded NRC Region I Combined Inspection Reports 50-387/83-23 and 50-338/83-21 with Appendices A and B, Notices of Violation.

Your Notices advised that PP&L was to submit a written reply within thirty (30) days of the date of the letter. However, your letter indicated that PP&L is not required to respond to Violation A.2. In addition, as discussed with Mr. E. C. McCabe of NRC Region I on February 3, 1984, PP&L has been authorized to delay its response to Violation A.1 until March 2, 1984. PP&L's response to Violation B is attached. Pursuant to 10CFR2.790(d), the attachment should be withheld from public inspection.

We trust that the Commission will find the attached responses acceptable.
