


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justify its late filing. Thus the contentions should be rejected.

The contentions are all directed at Hampton's own plan. The Applicants have already indicated in prior responses to the Towns of Kensington and South Hampton that local communities should not be heard to attack their own plans in NRC fora.

For all of the foregoing reasons, the contentions filed by Hampton on September 29, 1983 should be excluded.
