The Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L) letter, AECM-83/0617, dated September 28, 1983, requested withdrawal of proposed Technical Specification changes pertaining to safety related mechanical snubbers from further Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) review due to an administrative error. Additionally, MP&L committed to revise and formally resubmit the subject changes by October 7, 1983. Consistent with that commitment, MP&L is providing for your review and approval the revised proposed changes to Grand Gulf Nuclear Station Technical Specifications. These changes have been reviewed and approved by the Plant Safety Review Committee (PSRC) and the Safety Review Committee (SRC).

The changes proposed are administrative in nature and update the subject Technical Specification table to be consistent with plant design and to correct certain typographical errors. As stated in AECM-83/0617, the subject changes constitute the final portion of changes identified in MP&L's recent review of surveillance procedures and associated technical specification surveillance requirements and are not required to support the current critical operations nor power ascension testing. This extensive review was performed consistent with NRC direction provided to MP&L in the "Confirmation of Action" letter Mr. J. P. O'Reilly to Mr. D. C. Lutken, dated October 20, 1982 (MAEC-82/242).

The subject changes have been evaluated by MP&L in accordance with the guidelines of 10CFR 50.92. On the basis of that evaluation, MP&L has determined that the subject changes involve no "significant hazard consideration." Justification for this determination is provided in the attached information.

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
