By letter (Reference 2) dated September 12, 1983, Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L) agreed to provide to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) definitions for the terms "channel," "trip systems," and "trip functions" as they are used in the Technical Specifications. Also as part of this commitment, MP&L agreed to verify that the single failure criterion has been properly applied in the instrumentation section of the Technical Specifications.

By letter (Reference 3) dated December 15, 1983, MP&L provided the subject information for Technical Specification Table 3.3.2-1, Isolation Actuation Instrumentation. The remainder of the information was to be provided by February 15, 1984. Although the basic review necessary to obtain this information has been completed, the formal submittal requires approximately four weeks of more detailed review prior to submittal. MP&L is, therefore, formally requesting an extension of the due date for the balance of the information until March 16, 1984. This date has been discussed by telephone with the NRC Project Manager and found by him to be acceptable.


