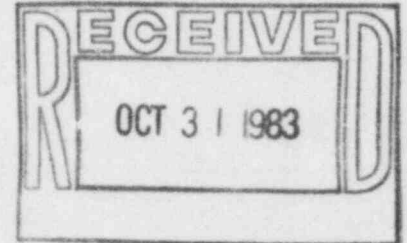

Gentlemen:

By letter dated August 30, 1983 (ØCANØ88316) AP&L provided a response to the subject inspection report. Due to an oversight, the response did not address a portion of one of the items listed in the report. The purpose of this letter is to provide AP&L's response to the omitted item. Inspection report item 3(b) (50-313/8316-05 and 50-368/8316-05) is repeated below followed by our response.

3. Failure to Follow Procedures in Requalification Training

10 CFR 50, Appendix B, Criterion V, requires, in part, "Activities affecting quality shall be prescribed by documented instructions, procedures . . . and shall be accomplished in accordance with these instructions, procedures"

- b. Arkansas Nuclear One Procedure 1063.08 also requires, in part, that licensed non-shift personnel participate in requalification training by, "Attendance of lectures in the categories in which a grade of less than 80% was scored on the previous annual written examination."

Contrary to the above, licensed, non-shift personnel did not, in at least two cases for each unit, attend lectures in the categories in which they had scored less than 80% on the previous annual examination." (50-313/8316-05 and 50-368/8316-05)



Response:

The referenced requirement contained in procedure 1063.08 had been interpreted as allowing self-study of lecture material followed by successful completion of the examination in lieu of lecture attendance. However, subsequent to receipt of this inspection report, a memorandum was issued by the ANO General Manager to all non-shift Reactor and Senior Reactor Operator License holders specifying that actual classroom attendance is required. Full compliance has therefore been achieved.
