RESPONSE TO NRC INSPECTION REPORT
NOS. 50-266/83-15 AND 50-301/83-15
POINT BEACH NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2

The following is in response to I&E Inspection Report Nos. 50-266/83-15 and 50-301/83-15 dated October 25, 1983. These reports included a Notice of Violation which stated that contrary to procedure PBNP 4.16, Revision 2, "Log Books & Records", Point Beach Operations personnel failed to make an entry in the station log that a bomb threat had been received. At 0056 hours on August 3, 1983 Point Beach Security personnel received a bomb threat via the telephone. Security personnel informed Operations personnel in the control room of the bomb threat at 0105 hours on August 3 at which time a station log entry should have been made but was not. This item is accepted as an item of noncompliance.

Immediate corrective action was carried out regarding the specific event by performing a late entry into the log at 1900 hours on August 3.

In addition, the following corrective action has been completed. Each Shift Superintendent has again received a copy of the subject procedure, PBNP 4.16, Revision 2, which he has reviewed along with his Operating Supervisor. Also, since many of the events requiring a station log entry, such as a bomb threat, occur infrequently, a consolidated list of station log entry items developed from PBNP 4.16 has been posted in the control room near the Duty Shift Superintendent's watch desk. This posting will



All corrective action will be completed by December 16, 1983.
