RESPONSE TO IE BULLETIN 83-06

Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

In accordance with IE Bulletin 83-06, "Nonconforming Materials Supplied by Tube-Line Corporation Facilities at Long Island City, New York; Houston, Texas; and Carol Stream, Illinois," Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) has completed a review of the list of purchasing and receiving companies given in Attachments 2 and 3 of the bulletin. Carolina Power & Light Company has also conducted a review to identify construction, operations, Architect Engineer and Nuclear Steam Supply System vendor procured items with Tube-Line (T-L) materials. Based upon these reviews, CP&L has determined that to the best of our knowledge, no T-L material has been purchased or received by Brunswick Steam Electric Plant.

The general concerns expressed in IEB 83-06 have also been reviewed and are applicable to BSEP. Carolina Power & Light Company is investigating the possible use of additional inspection and testing during receipt inspection to strengthen our QA program capabilities in detection of fraudulently supplied material. This investigation is scheduled for completion during the first quarter of 1984. Carolina Power & Light Company will submit a description of the results of the investigation and a schedule for implementation of any actions resulting therefrom by June 1, 1984.


