The referenced letter was MP&L's response to the subject inspection report, including Notice of Deviation 416/83-10-04. MP&L intends to revise its commitment concerning this deviation.

The security guard post that was established to control access to and inspect the cabinets will be deleted. An appropriate form of access control and cabinet inspection such as roving guards or posting personnel will be re-established only during extended periods of outage work. This change is justified since work in these panels is minimal and construction manpower has been removed from the area. Additionally, we wish to minimize unnecessary personnel in the Control Room.
