Dear Mr. Bordenick:

As you are aware, FEMA is presently conducting a plan review of the LILCO Transition Plan for Shoreham as requested under the NRC-FEMA Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). FEMA's involvement in the present Atomic Safety Licensing Board Hearing is pursuant to the terms of that MOU. FEMA has informal requests pending from two of the parties to this proceeding to review additional information relative to the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station. FEMA feels that such submissions should be made to the NRC for determination whether they will be forwarded to FEMA at this time pursuant to the MOU. In this situation, it is properly the NRC/FEMA Steering Committee's determination as to which documents should be reviewed.

During the course of a normal 44 CFR 350 review process FEMA has received additional data from all sources. If questions arose necessitating clarification of the plan such clarification could be acquired directly from the party (Governor's representative) who submitted the plan. In that the NRC has submitted the LILCO Transition Plan to FEMA any additional submissions should come from the NRC as they have to determine the consequences of these reviews on hearing schedules and other matters.

FEMA has also received requests from two of the parties to meet with the Region II staff to discuss aspects of the Plan Review. FEMA is willing to accommodate each party. As these meetings would relate to issues before the ASLB we feel it would be appropriate for members of your staff to be in attendance.
