

The counsel for the parties discussed a list of 67 contentions that the Intervenors were considering having dismissed. The parties have signed a Voluntary Agreement to Dismiss Contentions which dismisses those contentions, and this has been filed with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

The parties also discussed settlement of contentions that were not dismissed but were not able to come to any agreement on settlement of those contentions.

The parties will advise the Board about the results of any further settlement discussions.
