WHEREAS, the people of Cumberland County voted against the restart of TMI, in a public and open referendum, in the amount of 2-1, and

WHEREAS, the people of Cumberland County have clearly demonstrated and expressed their opinion that they desire a swift, safe and sure resolution to this matter;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Cumberland County strongly support the Commissioners of Dauphin County, adding our voice to their request that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission proceed with the decontamination of TMI and thereon close both Unit I and Unit II of TMI, removing the uncertainty and threat from the people of our counties once and for all.
