



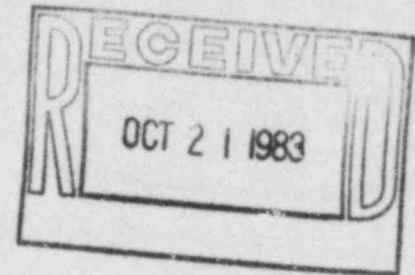

Gentlemen:

This is our ninth monthly report on the progress of the Regulatory Response and Commitment Control Program. Following is a discussion of progress on each major area of the program on which we are required to report status.

1. Verification of implementation of commitments made since January 1, 1979.

As previously stated, this item is closed.

2. Procedure revision and commitment tracking.

Our review of several commitment tracking "systems" is complete. Information which summarizes the need for such a system and which describes its scope and intended operation, and which also contains recommendations for vendor, schedules, etc., is now being assembled for final management review and approval.

3. Priority scheme for nuclear regulatory issues.

Our review of the priority scheme guidelines is continuing. As stated, application of these guidelines to the commitment tracking system is being considered.

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
