The purpose of this letter is to advise the NRC of Duke Power Company's intent to rerack the McGuire Nuclear Station Units 1 and 2 spent fuel pools (SFP) and to assist the NRC in scheduling licensing activities.

Duke Power is presently planning to transmit the McGuire Nuclear Station SFP rerack licensing submittal to the NRC in March 1984. We would like to have Duke Power and Westinghouse personnel meet with NRC representatives to discuss the proposed reracking. A meeting date of January 31, 1983 is suggested.
