Saegert Regarding Contention 65 (Evacuation Time Estimates);

2. Suffolk County Response to LILCO and NRC Staff Motions to Strike the Testimony of Fred C. Finlayson, Gregory C. Minor and Edward P. Radford on Behalf of Suffolk County Regarding Contentions 65, 23.D and 23.H; and

3. Suffolk County's Response to LILCO's Motion to Strike Portions of the Testimony of Inspector Richard C. Roberts, et al. on Contentions 65 and 23.H.

Although cross-examination of the Finlayson panel has been deferred until after the filing of Group II testimony as was noted during the hearing last week, the Board's decision on the motions to strike the Finlayson testimony will have an impact on the testimony to be filed by the Finlayson witness panel on certain Group II issues. The witnesses are currently in the process of preparing such testimony. Accordingly, while unlike the traffic-related motions a ruling on the Finlayson motions is

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
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not a prerequisite to the progress of the Group I litigation, we nonetheless request an early issuance of the Board's ruling on the Finlayson motions so it can be taken into account in preparing Group II testimony.
