We request all documents related to Facility License No. R-86 issued to Lockheed Aircraft Corporation, circa 1962, by the Atomic Energy Commission, including a copy of the license, the License Termination Order (Docket No. 50-172, August 31, 1972) and all other documents relevant to the issuance of the license, any amendments to the license, and the termination of the license.

Please note the following exclusions and limitations concerning this request. First, we are not seeking the disclosure of any contractor proprietary or confidential information. Any such information should be deleted from any document responsive to this request so that the document may be disclosed. Second, we are not seeking the disclosure of any information that is currently classified. Any such information should be deleted from any document responsive to this request so that the document may be disclosed.



The Freedom of Information Act provides that if some parts of the requested documents are exempt from mandatory disclosure, "reasonably segregable" portions shall be provided. Therefore, if you determine that some portion of a requested document is exempt we ask that you provide us with a copy of the remainder of the document. Additionally, if you determine that some or all of the requested documents are exempt from disclosure we ask that you provide us with a list or index of the documents withheld, the statutory exemption invoked, and the reason for the invocation of any exemption in each case. We reserve our right to appeal any and all decisions to withhold information.

We agree to pay all reasonable costs associated with the search for and reproduction of the documents requested. If, however, you estimate that such costs will exceed \$200, please contact me before incurring costs in excess of that amount.

Finally, by the terms of 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(A), we expect your determination on release of the requested documents within ten working days of this request.
