

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


AMENDMENT OF DEFINITION OF INSURED





The city limit of Rock Hill (South Carolina) is located approximately 5.8 miles
south-southwest of the site and the Charlotte (North Carolina) city limit is
located approximately 10.5 miles east-northeast of the Catawba site.
