Pursuant to the requirements of Amendment 5 to the Construction Permits for the Hope Creek Generating Station, we hereby transmit to you the attached report on monitoring of activities related to the shipment of liquefied natural gas (LNG) and liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) on the Delaware River.

The attachment consists of a summary and introduction section, followed by an annual report which summarizes the results of the monitoring of activities on the Delaware River.

The results of this study show that the shipping activity of interest has decreased slightly, and that no new or proposed construction which could have an effect on the probability calculations has apparently been authorized.
