

Dear Mr. Romano:

This letter will confirm our telephone conversation of today regarding your response to "Applicant's First Set of Interrogatories and Request for Production of Documents to Intervenor Air and Water Pollution Patrol on Contention VI-1." I stated that I calculated that your response was required to be filed on January 3, 1984, but that I had not received a copy in the mail. You, in turn, stated that your response had not yet been filed, but that you would assure that I received your complete response by Friday, January 13, 1984, in Philadelphia at the hearing. Based upon this agreement, I am withholding the filing of a motion to compel discovery.

If your commitment is not met, I will seek sanctions before the Licensing Board including dismissal of this contention.
