THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE'S ANSWER TO APPLICANTS'  
MOTION TO COMPEL SUPPLEMENTARY ANSWERS TO  
INTERROGATORIES FROM THE NEW HAMPSHIRE ATTORNEY GENERAL  
(CONTENTION NH-10)

By Motion dated December 21, 1983 Applicants asked that New Hampshire be compelled to file supplemental answers to interrogatories propounded by the Applicant on December 8, 1982. New Hampshire answered those interrogatories in a complete and timely fashion.

As to interrogatories II-2 through II-7, New Hampshire could not particularize its answers because the Detailed Control Room Design Review had (DCRDR) had not been completed. Now that the DCRDR has been submitted, New Hampshire will voluntarily provide answers to these interrogatories.

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Furthermore, New Hampshire indicated in its answers to interrogatories II-8 and II-10 that it would be in a position to answer these interrogatories after it had reviewed the DCRDR. Consequently, New Hampshire will also furnish answers to these two interrogatories.

New Hampshire will provide these answers within thirty days, or within such other time period as the Board may designate.

The remaining interrogatories (II-1, II-9, II-10, II-11, and II-12) have been answered in full, and the answers are not dependent on New Hampshire's review of the DCRDR. These interrogatories, therefore, need not be supplemented.
