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
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FOREWORD

This Emergency Plan establishes the policies and practices to be followed at Cooper Nuclear Station in the unlikely event that an emergency situation should occur. Additions, deletions, or modifications to the policies and practices contained herein must have approval of the Assistant General Manager - Nuclear before such changes can be incorporated.

The Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures (EPIPs) and General Office Guidelines (GOGs) for CNS Emergency Response Activities are the documents which implement the requirements of this Plan. Additions, deletions, or modifications to the EPIPs are made in accordance with the CNS Administrative Procedures. Changes made to the GOGs are the responsibility of the Assistant General Manager - Nuclear.

Copies of this Plan and the implementing documents shall be serially numbered and shall be issued via a system of controlled distribution which will assure that all copies remain current.
