The following information is provided in response to I&E Bulletin 83-08.

Offshore Power Systems has neither purchased nor as yet specified circuit breakers for safety-related applications. Therefore, items 1, 2a, 2b and 2c of the action list cannot be addressed at this time. Regarding action item 2d, accumulated circuit breaker reliability data will form the future basis both for breaker selection and preventative maintenance recommendations to Floating Nuclear Power owners. Since no further design activities are planned prior to obtaining a customer, Offshore Power Systems cannot provide a meaningful implementation schedule.
