The purpose of this letter is to inform the NRC Staff of a change in date for presenting Northeast Nuclear Energy Company's (NNECO) plan for conducting a self-assessment using the service water system operational performance inspection (SWSOPI) module at Millstone Unit No. 2.


In a letter dated February 10, 1995,⁽¹⁾ NNECO informed the NRC of NNECO's plan to conduct a SWSOPI at Millstone Unit No. 2 beginning September 25, 1995, and requested a meeting in May 1995 with the NRC for presenting the details of NNECO's self assessment plan.

As discussed with Mr. E. M. Kelly of the NRC Staff, NNECO wishes to change the date for presentation to the NRC from May 1995 to June 1995. Specifically, we are requesting a meeting on June 28, 1995, with the NRC for presenting the details of our self assessment plan. The proposed date for the performance of the SWSOPI module at Millstone Unit No. 2 remains unchanged.
