Appendix R Appeal Meeting

Gentlemen:

On January 24 and 25, 1983, several telephone conversations were held between our respective staffs to discuss the Appendix R appeal meeting scheduled for January 28, 1983. Our understanding of the results of those conversations is:

- (1) the NRC will respond favorably (i.e., grant) all exemption requests which were addressed in our letter to the NRC dated November 11, 1982 (ØCAN11821Ø),
- (2) the subject of partial versus full suppression system coverage potentially at issue on our docket will be treated in an expeditious fashion as a generic issue and initially discussed outside of individual utility appeal meetings, and
- (3) the remaining appeal items requested in our December 28 letter, i.e., source range monitor and capability for cold shutdown within 72 hours, will be addressed in an appeal meeting presently scheduled for AP&L for February 16, 1983.

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
