
Gentlemen:

By letter dated August 24, 1994, Georgia Power Company (GPC) provided a response to Generic Letter 94-03. The response indicated GPC's plans to implement a permanent repair on Unit 1 during the Fall 1994 refueling outage and provided an attachment describing the stabilizer assemblies associated with the repair. Also, by letter dated September 23, 1994, GPC provided a response to a request for additional information related to the core shroud stabilizer design previously submitted. The information provided contained some information that was marked proprietary.

The information marked proprietary does not need to be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with the provisions of 10CFR2.790 (a)(4) and 10CFR2.790(b), as GPC's submittals did not include such a request. Consequently, the information in the above submittals should not be considered exempt from public disclosure.
