

Applicants will maintain the requested documents assembled in Carolina Power & Light Company offices, available for inspection by Mr. Eddleman, for a reasonable time (i.e., through May 18, 1984), after which they will be returned to their place of origin.

Inspected documents which Mr. Eddleman wishes to have copied will be reproduced by Carolina Power & Light Company on a schedule compatible with other demands for duplicating equipment. A Carolina Power & Light Company employee will be available during the inspection in order to receive any requests for copying. Copies of such selected documents will then be furnished to Mr. Eddleman upon payment of 7 cents per page, to meet Carolina Power & Light Company's cost of reproduction.
