In reviewing our file on the EIS related work concerning the Limerick Generating Station, I have found an egregious and unfortunate error in the second paragraph of the first technical comment, Statistics and Probability. The word "designed" in the fourth line is misspelled and should read "design".

The sense of this paragraph is probably better stated as an "either or" situation. The TMI accident was either a design failure or a design accident compounded by operator judgement.

Hopefully this will clear up any questions that may have arisen over this misspelling.
