



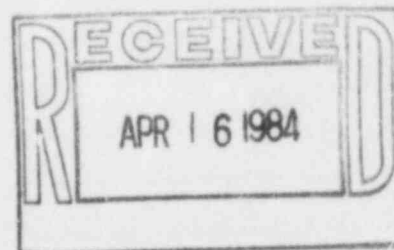

Dear Mr. Collins:

In response to the referenced IE Information Notice, Public Service Company of Colorado is hereby requesting an exemption from the requirements set forth in Section IV.F.1 of Appendix E to 10 CFR Part 50. This exemption pertains to the lack of participation by State and local governments in the 1984 Fort St. Vrain Radiological Emergency Exercise (FOSAVEX-84), to be held in late June, 1984.

Attached please find a letter dated March 22, 1984, from the Colorado Division of Disaster Emergency Services (DODES) to FEMA, stating DODES' intentions not to exercise their radiological emergency plans during this year's Fort St. Vrain emergency exercise. Public Service Company requests NRC approval of this exemption in conjunction with FEMA approval.




Dear Mr. Cook:

Pursuant to reference Colorado will exercise its option not to conduct an exercise of the Fort St. Vrain Radiological Emergency Response Plan in 1984. This decision is based upon the conduct of a satisfactory joint exercise with the Public Service Company in June, 1983 and a personnel vacancy which cannot be filled until July 1, 1984.

The State will cooperate with and support the Public Service Company when they conduct their on-site Plant exercise later this year. This support will include activation of communications links and partial manning of the Weld County and State Emergency Operations Centers. This Division will also devote effort to needed revision of the off-site response plan in preparation for the 1985 exercise.

This action will necessitate a modification to Comprehensive Cooperative Agreement EMD-K-0079.
