Motion to Require Service of All Amendments or
Changes to Emergency Plan on Intervenor
and
Amendment to Emergency Planning Contentions

Intervenor Wells Eddleman hereby moves the Board, to the extent Applicants have not already committed to do so, to require service of all amendments or changes to the Harris offsite emergency plan on intervenor. In support of this motion, I point out that the present plan is quite incomplete (e.g. as shown in the contentions filed April 12 by me); that it is an unreasonable burden to always be checking with various state and county offices for changes in the plan; and that the public right to know concerning such plan will be served by service of all such amendments on intervenor. In fairness I believe that such amendments or changes should also be served on all other parties

Under 10 CFR 2.714, it being 15 days until the prehearing conference, Wells Eddleman hereby amends his contentions by adding this preamble to the contention filing of April 12: Because the plan is incomplete, I request leave to amend or modify these contentions as new information becomes available; also I assume that for new information (e.g. changes to the plan) I have 30 days from the time the document is in my hand to file new or amended contentions based thereon.
