I am writing this letter to up-date the last letter I sent you on June 2, 1982, concerning the "emergency evacuation plan" for the area around or near Indian Point.


I am sorry to say that we have not yet reached any understanding with any responsible party concerning a "safe" evacuation plan for the Indian Point Plant.

We, as a Union and as part of the community, are deeply concerned for the safety of all involved. However, I must once again state, "This Union will not allow any member of the Union to be involved unless each and every detail has been discussed with us and then, of course, with our members."

Therefore, it is still our position that as of this date there is not evacuation plan that our members are involved with.
