Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit 3  
Transmittal of Draft Modified Amended Security Plan  
Including Millstone Unit 3 Physical Security Features

In Reference (1), Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) outlined the primary features of the physical security plan for Millstone Unit 3, as part of its Operating License application for the Unit. Reference (3) requested that NNECO amend its physical security, guard training and qualification, and safeguards contingency plans for Millstone Units 1 and 2, to incorporate Unit 3 physical security features, as part of the NRC's review of the Millstone Unit 3 FSAR, section 13.6, "Physical Security Plan."

In accordance with 10CFR50.34(c) and 10CFR Part 73, NNECO hereby submits a Draft Modified Amended Security Plan (MASP) which includes Millstone Unit 3 physical security features (Attachment II). This Draft MASP is based on proposed Revision 19 of the Millstone Units 1 and 2 MASP which will be submitted for your review shortly. Millstone Unit 3 specific changes from proposed Revision 19 are indicated by vertical bars in the right-hand margin. A summary of these changes is provided in Attachment I.

This Draft MASP will be submitted to the NRC as a formal revision to the Millstone Units 1 and 2 MASP prior to its implementation. The Millstone Unit 3 MASP will be fully implemented prior to fuel load, presently scheduled for November 1985.

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


