Dear Dr. Murley:

As previously reported in the above referenced correspondence, the Safety Parameter Display System (SPDS) was not operational by the commitment date in our operating license. We are currently encountering difficulties with testing and installation of the system. Our Engineering Group is evaluating the current problems and reviewing the progress to date.

A firm date has not been established as to when the SPDS will be operational. An implementation schedule, including an operational date will be submitted by the end of January.

Extending the completion date for SPDS does not reduce our ability to deal with an emergency. The reasons for this position remain the same as those provided to Mr. A. Schwencer of NRR in PLA-1717, dated June 23, 1983.
