In accordance with 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, Part IV, Section F.1, TVA will conduct the 1984 emergency preparedness exercise for the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant in July. The State of Tennessee desires to exercise the option given them in 44 CFR 350, which requires full State and local participation on a biennial basis. The State's position is detailed in the enclosed letters from the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency (TEMA) to TVA. State and local participation will be limited in 1984 and will not meet the 10 CFR Appendix E requirements for an annual full-scale exercise. This letter constitutes an exemption request to those requirements.

TVA supports the State's request because of the high evaluation ratings they received in Sequoyah's 1983 exercise and because they will be participating fully in the Watts Bar Nuclear Plant exercise which is presently scheduled for June 1984.

In order that we may finalize our planning process for the 1984 exercise, we request your immediate attention to this request.


Dear Mr. Sliger:
