In a motion filed on April 16, 1984, intervenor Wells Eddleman asks the Board: (1) to require Applicants to serve all amendments or changes to the Harris off-site emergency plan on intervenors; and (2) for leave to amend or modify his relevant contentions as new information becomes available.


