APPLICANTS' PROPOSED SCHEDULE FOR
EMERGENCY PLANNING ISSUES

Because of the delay in the availability of the off-site emergency response plans for the Shearon Harris Nuclear Power Plant, it is necessary to adjust the schedule for Emergency Preparedness Contentions set in the Board's Memorandum and Order (Reflecting Decisions Made Following Second Prehearing Conference), at 8 (March 10, 1983). Applicants propose the following schedule, which assumes the issuance of Board rulings on the admissibility of proposed contentions on or before mid-May, 1984:

August 9, 1984: Last day for filing discovery requests.

August 30, 1984: Last day for filing responses to discovery requests.

November 1, 1984: Last day for filing any motion for summary disposition.

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November 19, 1984: Last day to answer any motion for summary disposition.

December 19, 1984: Board ruling on any motion for summary disposition.

January 14, 1985: Filing of direct written testimony.

February 4, 1985: Commencement of hearing.

This proposed schedule preserves the previously established hearing date, yet avoids, to the extent possible consistent with timely completion of the hearing, conflicts for intervenors participating in the management capability/safety hearings.

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
