Dear Mr. Quay:

Enclosed is a diskette that contains a file with the ORIGIN code output for the AP600 that was requested by RAI 470.22. The code version used is 2.1. Because the input is included, the file is considered to be Westinghouse proprietary. The information being transmitted is in a file called AP6NRC.ZIP and is in compressed form using the PKZIP utility. The actual uncompressed file is approximately 2.4 Meg in size. The PKUNZIP executable file is also included on the diskette to permit file expansion. A copy of the enclosure has been sent separately to Mr. Jack Donohew to forward to Mr. Jay Lee of the NRC.


