
On November 4, 1983, South Carolina Electric and Gas Company (SCE&G) responded in part to Generic Letter 83-28, "Required Actions Based on Generic Implications of Salem ATWS Events." As stated in the November 6, 1983 letter, SCE&G was an active member of the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations (INPO) coordinated Nuclear Utility Task Action Committee (NUTAC) formed to address the requirements found in Section 2.2.2 of the Generic Letter. The NUTAC sought to find a solution to the NRC's concerns as expressed in Section 2.2.2, and the results of their efforts are presented in the "Vendor Equipment Technical Information Program (VETIP)" report. This final report was transmitted to the NRC and the NUTAC members by the Chairman of the NUTAC upon final publication of the document in March 1984.

SCE&G is presently reviewing this final VETIP report. The SCE&G plant specific program is expected to be developed using guidance found in this VETIP document. After a complete review of the document, SCE&G will submit to the Staff the Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station's specific program description. This description is expected to be completed by SCE&G in September 1984.
