



Dear Mr. President:

It has come to my attention that a nuclear facility on Turkey Point in Southeastern Florida, which is run by Florida Power and Light, a major utility in Florida, there is a leak that is releasing tens of thousands of gallons of radioactive water a week, and almost a million gallons of the same substance in one year.

Florida Power & Light has dismissed the leak as being unharful to human beings and to the environment despite the fact that if a person tries to close up the leak, he can be killed by radiation poisoning.

I would recommend that you ask the Atomic Energy Commission, the Department of Interior, and the Council for Environmental Quality to make investigations into this problem. Something must be done-and it must be done by you. Please, stand up for the American people rather than big-business interests, before you lose some of your constituents and voters-the easy way!
