IE Bulletin 80-11, Masonry Wall Design
Request for Additional Information

Dear Sir:

In a letter dated February 29, 1984, responding to a request for additional information regarding IE Bulletin 80-11, Florida Power Corporation (FPC) indicated alternatives were being evaluated to determine the best controls to assure that future plant modifications would not place safety-related equipment in an area that could be compromised by a non-seismically qualified wall. By this letter, FPC documents the results of that evaluation.

A letter will be issued to all FPC personnel and architect engineers involved in safety-related designs notifying them of the need to determine that non-seismically qualified walls will not adversely affect plant modifications.

All non-seismically qualified masonry block walls in seismic Class 1 structures will be marked to indicate that no safety-related equipment should be placed in the vicinity.

A change will be made to the design data sheet check list contained within the safety-related engineering procedures to require, for each modification, documentation of the fact that potential adverse effects from non-seismically qualified masonry walls in the area have been considered in the design.


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These controls, which will be in place by August 1, 1984, will assure that no safety-related equipment will be placed in an area that could be compromised by a nearby non-seismically qualified masonry wall. 


