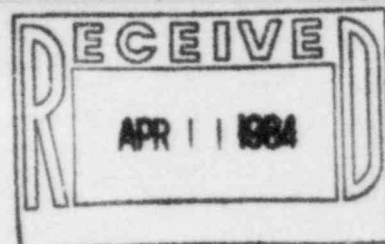

Demonstration of Accountability On-Site

Dear Sir:

Accountability of on-site personnel following an evacuation is an NRC concern resulting from the NRC Emergency Preparedness Appraisal conducted January 30, 1984 through February 10, 1984 and the emergency exercise performed by LP&L on February 8, 1984. Accountability and evacuation verification procedures were not in place for appraisal team review during the appraisal period, nor was all hardware installation complete for the accountability demonstration.

The procedures and hardware necessary to perform accountability will be in place prior to fuel load, and the full accountability demonstration will be completed prior to exceeding 5% power. We believe this commitment is consistent with NRC regulation and will serve to satisfy compliance to this NRC Emergency Planning requirement to support issuance of the Waterford SES #3 operating license.
