SUBJECT: Application for Amendment of Operating License

Enclosed please find Omaha Public Power District's (OPPD) "Application for Amendment of Operating License" which seeks to amend Specifications 2.3 and 2.4 of the Fort Calhoun Station Unit No. 1 Technical Specifications. The changes requested are required to provide additional restrictions on the operation of the Component Cooling Water (CCW) system heat exchangers to ensure that CCW system temperatures are maintained within its analyzed design basis. The issue of elevated temperatures in the CCW system was reported to the NRC in Licensee Event Report 94-10, dated December 14, 1994.

Attachment A contains a markup reflecting the requested changes of the Technical Specifications. Attachment B provides the "Discussion, Justification and No Significant Hazards Consideration."
