APPLICANT'S MOTION TO SUBSTITUTE CERTAIN
ONSITE EMERGENCY PLAN IMPLEMENTING
PROCEDURES IN APPLICANT EXHIBIT 33

As the Licensing Board and other parties are aware, Applicant's Emergency Plan and implementing procedures are evolving documents whose revision from time to time is required, based upon periodic updates and refinements. Under this process, revisions to several procedures were under review and approval. Counsel for the Applicant incorrectly understood that the procedures offered in evidence were then current. Since they were not, Applicant now moves to substitute the latest revisions for the seven procedures which have been updated. Copies of the revisions are attached and marked with the corresponding exhibit number.

The changes incorporated in the revision of the procedures are clarifications and refinements of the previous version and do not affect the function or mission of the individuals or groups responsible for carrying out the


procedures or the manner in which their activities under the procedures are performed.

With the exception of Dr. Linnemann whose testimony did not involve these procedures, each of Applicant's witnesses has reviewed the revised procedures and has determined that none of the revisions would require a change in his or her testimony before the Board. Further, counsel for Applicant has independently reviewed the revisions and reached the same conclusion.

Accordingly, to correct the record and provide the Board and parties with the current version of the procedures, Applicant moves that the revised procedures enumerated on the attached Appendix A be substituted for the corresponding procedures received into evidence.


