FEMA Finding on LILCO Transition  
Plan For Shoreham

Dear Mr. Schwencer:

In response to your letter of April 2, 1984 to Mr. M. S. Pollock, LILCO has reviewed the FEMA Findings and Comments on LILCO's Transition Plan for Shoreham contained in the attachment to your letter. We have prepared draft responses to these Findings and Comments. We have also, through the NRC's good offices, scheduled a meeting with FEMA for May 11, 1984, to discuss them.

You have also asked us to address the legal concerns that FEMA specified in their review. We believe all actions proposed under the LERO Transition Plan have sufficient legal authority to be carried out. As you are aware, this matter is presently in litigation, as a result of suits filed by Suffolk County and the State of New York. Furthermore, FEMA has subsequently written a letter to Director of Regulations, April 26, 1984, giving more definition of their position concerning legal authority issues at Shoreham. I have attached that letter for your reference. If you have any questions, do not hesitate to contact me.
