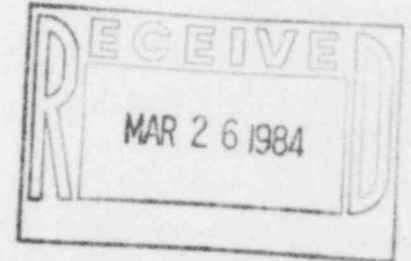

NRC IE Bulletin 83-08, "Electrical Circuit Breakers with an Undervoltage Trip Feature in Use in Safety-Related Applications Other Than the Reactor Trip System," has been reviewed by Houston Lighting & Power Company. The investigation determined that the South Texas Project has no circuit breakers with an undervoltage trip attachment in safety-related applications other than as reactor trip breakers. 


