Louisiana Power & Light Company, Applicant in the above captioned proceeding, hereby files Amendment No. 35 to its Application for Licenses.


This Amendment No. 35 amends the Final Safety Analysis Report Application to include miscellaneous changes resulting from final construction and startup problems.







Please find enclosed 60 copies and 3 originals of Amendment 35 to the Waterford 3 FSAR.

In recent discussions with our NRC Licensing Project Manager, it was determined that an additional FSAR Amendment would be desirable prior to issuance of the Waterford 3 Operating License. However, because few Licensing issues remain open, and the Waterford 3 design is essentially finalized, this amendment consists primarily of miscellaneous changes resulting from construction and startup problems of the type normally encountered while preparing for fuel load. None of the enclosed changes significantly affect in any way Waterford 3 safety analyses. All FSAR changes related to licensing issues critical to the operating license have already been docketed by letter and discussed with the cognizant NRC reviewer.





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
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
