

Attachment 1, Contingency Event Report - Salem Generating Station, is forwarded in accordance with the provisions of 10CFR73.71. This report documents the receipt of a bomb threat and the implementation of the SGS Security Contingency Plan. The threat was judged to have been a hoax. An extensive search was conducted and no suspicious device was discovered. The Security Supervisor notified NRC Region I; the Senior Shift Supervisor notified the NRC Operations Center. A Contingency Event Log was also maintained, which details, chronologically, the implementation of the Security Contingency Plan. That document is available at Salem Generating Station for the NRC's inspection.
